Project PARI – Empowering Adolescent Girls with Dignity, Education, and Health

Project Overview: A comprehensive Menstrual Health and Hygiene (MHM) initiative that empowers adolescent girls through access to hygiene products, health education, and community engagement. By addressing stigma and promoting awareness, the project ensures that menstruation never disrupts girls' education, confidence, or dignity.

Key Objectives

- Promote awareness and understanding of menstrual health among adolescent girls.
- Ensure access to menstrual hygiene kits and safe practices.
- Break the stigma surrounding menstruation through community dialogue.
- Foster confidence, attendance, and participation among school-going girls.

Location: Guwahati, Assam

Target: School-going adolescent girls

Awareness & Education Sessions: Conducted in schools and communities

Community Engagement: Involving students, teachers, and local leaders to normalize conversations around menstruation

PARI: Key Achievements

- **1321 Girls, 1231 Boys and 180 Teachers in 11 Schools** trained on menstrual health & hygiene management.
- **22 sessions** on menstrual health & hygiene management conducted at school and Community level.
- **2030 Sanitary Napkin Packets** were distributed.
- **80 Teachers & 300 students** strengthened as Menstrual Health Champions

Project Smart Gurukul – Digital Education & Blended Learning in Guwahati, Assam



Project Overview: The Smart Gurukul project focuses on strengthening the school learning ecosystem through four key components: upgrading digital infrastructure, enhancing teacher capacity with digital, mobile, and AI learning modules, integrating TWF–NSDC–aligned e-learning into the existing curriculum, and enriching student learning through art and craft, career coaching, and digital STEM activities. Together, these elements create a holistic, technology-enabled environment that improves teaching quality, broadens student exposure, and equips learners with essential future-ready skills.

Key Objectives

This initiative had a to ensure that government schools are equipped with the latest digital technology and resources to enhance the learning experience of students.

Impact and Reach

Location: Guwahati, Assam

Target: The We Foundation implemented digital education project in **11 institutions**, which have **01 school for children in special needs, 06 primary schools, 04 secondary schools** in Kamrup(metro), Guwahati, Assam.

Activity Overview

Online Teachers Training by Cognizant

- An online teacher training programme was initiated with an introductory session explaining the training structure, expectations, and objectives.
- Teachers collectively agreed on a weekly training schedule and shared their goals, especially improving digital integration and online teaching skills.
- The training team assured that customised materials would be provided to address challenges and support effective learning.
